

Seminar on « Woman and Social Development issues in Sub-Saharan Africa »

Woman enjoys a high status in the Islamic civilization and culture conferred upon her by the principles of our magnanimous Islamic religion which preceded all legislations and international instruments in honouring woman and consolidating her value in the society, enabling her to take on the mission devolved upon her as concerns edification of young generations. In fact, Islam holds woman to be equal to man and entitled to the same rights and has to abide by the same obligations thereby giving her free access to science and knowledge and enabling her to contribute most effectively to the Islamic scientific, educational and cultural resurgence.

However, circumstances in most Islamic societies are such that they do not favourably enable the woman to better discharge her social mission and assume her economic role in such a way as may achieve consistency for the whole society and pave the way for resurgence to take off, in accordance with the lofty Islamic principles decreed in Islam that enable the woman to take on the responsibilities devolved upon her within the framework of a united and well-knit social entity of which the main fulcrum is founded upon legal precepts and supreme values.

Infused with the belief that ample attention ought to be granted to the woman as regards her fields of competence, in such a way as to enable her to effectively contribute to the comprehensive development of society, the Islamic Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization scheduled under its successive action plans a series of activities, programmes and projects aimed at fostering her cultural, educational and scientific status. Therefore, the Islamic Organization held several specialised conferences and symposium, issued a variety of relevant studies and research works, and granted special attention to the training sessions and workshops on literacy for woman and on raising awareness about reproductive health. The Islamic Organization's activities also featured the Productive Woman project which is in the implementation process, the objective of which is to improve the economic situation of the woman and enable her to have free access to the labour market.



In consolidation of the endeavours directed by the Islamic Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization towards achieving integral and comprehensive development for the woman as regards cultural, social and economic aspects of life, and as part of its action plan for the years (2004-2006), the Islamic Organization intends to conduct, in cooperation with the World Islamic Call Society (WICS), a seminar on woman and social development issues in Sub-Saharan Africa, with a view to examining the conditions of the Muslim woman in this region, as well as to propose solutions to activate her role in comprehensive development, engaging participation of a group of teachers and specialised researchers.

Title of activity: Seminar on « Woman and Social Development Issues in Sub-Saharan Africa ».

Venue and date: Uganda, September 2004.

Benefiting states: The Gambia, Nigeria; Sierra Leone, and Nigeria.

Cooperating party: World Islamic Call Society.

Implementing party: The Islamic Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (ISESCO);

The World Islamic Call Society (WICS)

Framework: The Islamic Organization's Three-Year Action Plan (2004-2006).

Objectives:

- 1- To activate the role of woman in the process of social and cultural development, in compliance with the munificent Islamic principles and values.
- 2- To improve the living conditions of the Muslim woman in order to enable her to gain free access to the various fields of knowledge, availing of her capacities to support comprehensive and integral development in the Muslim societies.
- 3- To find efficient solutions for encouraging participation of woman in the efforts directed towards achieving development, taking into account her distinguishing specificities and her working conditions and adapting them to her social and family-related responsibilities.

Axes:

- Reproductive health and safe maternity: obstacles and solutions.
- Woman's social and economic role in reducing poverty.
- Woman's role in disseminating the culture of justice and peace.
